COVID-19

Thank you to our families and staff or following the most current protocols from Alberta Health Services. One question that we get asked a lot at the school is Following:

"If my child started isolating less than 10 days ago because they had symptoms of cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat on the screening questionnaire and they are feeling better now can they come to school?"

No. They must legally self-isolate for 10 days or until symptoms resolve whichever is longer.

If they get a negative COVID-19 test AND they have NO SYMPTOMS they may return to school.
