## Attendance Prizes

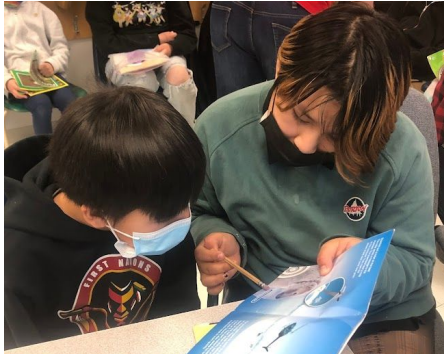
