- 1. If you do not have an account, go to https://www.crps.ca/registration and click the button to create a new account.
- 2. Then sign-in to https://powerschool.crps.ca/public/
- 3. Click on **ScholEngage** at the bottom of the left-hand menu.
- 4. Click on *Add Student* from the left-hand menu.



- 5. Then click on the student's name, followed by opening the registration form for the correct year.
- 6. Fill out the information on the form and upload any ID documents.
