






Report Cards

On February 26 Exshaw School will be celebrating Pink Shirt day! Pink Shirt Day began in Nova Scotia in 2007 when two high school



students took a stand against bullying after they saw a fellow student being harassed and threatened for wearing pink. These students bought dozens of pink shirts and distributed them to their classmates to wear the next day. The word got out online and hundreds of students showed up in pink, some from head-to-toe, to stand together against bullying. Since then Pink Shirt day has grown into a global movement. By wearing pink students are showing that they are against bullying, and that they believe in being kind.
